




Who this is for






Scenario 1 Capture data

Capture information

Scrape content from a wide range of files or sites and put it where it needs to go. Power Automate can automatically crawl and extract data from multiple pages. It automatically identifies patterns and datasets, intelligently selecting the type of information you specify.


Scenario 2 Automate email

Create powerful email automations

Trigger actions based on emails, such as detecting the arrival of an invoice or an approval from a manager. As soon as an email arrives that meets criteria you have defined, whether it's a purchase order or an impending deadline, the flow takes action to keep processes moving forward. You can also set up automations that send custom updates to stakeholders, including metrics, images, or other information.


Create reports

Simplify reporting

Capture data from multiple sources automatically and put it into reports of any format and file type. Spend more time interpreting and exploring data rather than simply copying and pasting it. 
Scenario 4 Verify forms

Automatically check for errors

Ensure everything is captured and the right type and format of information is present. Compare submitted information against existing data to identify discrepancies and errors. Return files to the sender with instructions for completion, automatically generated by Power Automate.




Scenario 5

Manage and monitor files

Trigger file downloads based on process steps or other actions and ensure files are placed in the proper location automatically. Automate operations such as naming, renaming, moving, deleting, and archiving based on a wide range of attributes. Monitor files and folders and act on changes using built-in triggers.




Scenario 6 **Update data**
